

CINNNAMON is pleased to present new work by Janneke van der Putten (Amsterdam, 1985, lives and works in Rotterdam), including video, performance, a workshop and textiles. Van der Putten discusses the theme "Quitsato" - or: the middle of the world - an old Ecuadorian concept about the geographical and astronomical perception of the sun and cyclical time measurement. The exhibition, entitled *Quitsa*, is a follow-up to previous presentations *All Begins With A* at TENT (Rotterdam, 2015) and *Directed to the Sun* at Atelierhaus Quartier am Hafen (Cologne, 2017). On January 7, Janneke van der Putten will lead the 'Voice and Space' workshop at the gallery.

Janneke van der Putten (Amsterdam, 1985) is a visual artist and vocalist based in Rotterdam. She graduated with a BDes from TXT (Textile), Gerrit Rietveld Academy (Amsterdam, 2009) and completed her MMus in Artistic Research, Royal Academy of Art & Royal Conservatoire (The Hague, 2013). She trained in classical North-Indian Dhrupad singing (Berlin & Rotterdam, 2009 – 2014) and is autodidact in various extended vocal techniques. The project 'Invisible Architecture' with Christian Galarreta, for which they published a vinyl in 2014, has been presented at amongst others Make the Audition: Meetings Between Art and Sound in Peru, Museo de Arte Contemporáneo (Lima, 2016) and nxnwfestival (Cologne, 2015). Van der Putten debuted with solo show *All Begins With A*, TENT (Rotterdam, 2015) and recently in Germany with *Directed to the Sun*, Atelierhaus Quartier am Hafen (Cologne, 2017). Van der Putten was artist-in-residence at the Centre international d'art et du paysage (Île de Vassivière, 2014), and is awarded a fellowship at Akademie Schloss Solitude (Stuttgart, 2019). Works presented in *Quitsa* are supported by CBK Rotterdam (Centre for Visual Arts Rotterdam), Aloardi artist-in-residency programme and Mondriaan Fund.
